SUMMARY OF POSITION

The Director of Grade School Discipleship provides the leadership of the Grade School Ministry at Eagle's Landing First Baptist Church (ELFBC). This position includes pastoral care, leadership development, developing teams, leading children's programs, and overseeing the spiritual instruction of grade school children.

This role will require developing a plan to reach the local schools, developing programs children will want to attend, lead children to be equipped to fulfill the mission of God, and lead a team of volunteers and leaders.

- Capable teacher that can teach groups with varying ages.

- A visionary leader with teaching, training, administrative, and organizational gifts.

- Ability to plan, mobilize people, and debrief with a team.
- Self-motivated with ability to function effectively without constant supervision, as well as work cohesively within a team environment.

- Must be a follower of Jesus Christ and have a lifestyle that demonstrates your love and commitment to Him.
- An active member of ELFBC or willing to become a member.

RESPONSIBILITIES

Oversee all grade school ministry initiatives, which include but are not limited to:

- Oversee primary weekly activities of Sunday morning LifeGroups, Elevate kids worship gathering, and Wednesday evening Saturate.

- Additional responsibilities with church-wide events such as Camp 323, CentriKid summer camp, Family fun nights, and others.
- Partner with parents to reach and raise a generation for Christ.
- Embrace and lead with ELFBC vision and values.
- Engage local schools and equip and mobilize volunteers to serve in those schools.
- Lead out in timely, consistent, and clear communication with children, parents, and volunteers.
- Recruit, train, empower, shepherd, and evaluate volunteers and leaders to serve in the ministry.
- Equip parents with resources to be the primary disciple-maker in their home.
- Connect children and their parents to discipleship ministries of the church.
- Prepare necessary reports regarding state of the grade school ministry and oversee the ministry budget.
