Please review the following carefully:

- Absolutely no admittance of Vape Pens, Alcohol, or Illegal Substances -Strictly prohibited for the safety of all.
- 2. Keep your affections for Jesus What does this mean?
 - a. No "Purple". Students will refrain from **PUBLIC AND PRIVATE** displays of affection including and especially in any romantic or intimate form.

 - b. If phones are out/discovered during these times, they will be confiscated.
 - c. All phones must be put away at lights out (our mindset on this, is we trust you to be mature enough to handle it until that trust is broken).
 - d. Phones can and will be taken for the remainder of camp period if students cannot abide by this policy.

- ii. We will all sit together in the worship center.
- iii. Service to be built around Next Generation ministries.

1. Bible, Notebook, Pen/Pencil
